

EARFLAP IRRITATION:

APPEARANCE: red, swollen ear flaps.

BEHAVIOR: Itching ears, wincing associated with ear contact, ear tenderness.

SKIN & COAT ISSUES:

APPEARANCE: thicker coat, acne, increased bruising, bacterial/fungal infection, scabbing.

BEHAVIOR: excessive shedding, scratching, tender areas of skin.

GINGIVAL HYPERPLASIA:

APPEARANCE: overgrowth of gum tissue.

BEHAVIOR: mouth sensitivity, difficulty chewing, red/swollen gums.

MUSCLE CRAMPS/WEAKNESS:

APPEARANCE: sluggish, shows pain doing everyday tasks.

BEHAVIOR: lethargic, limping, difficulty walking long distances & raising itself after lying down.

UPSET STOMACH:

APPEARANCE: distended belly, sluggish.

BEHAVIOR: decrease in appetite, difficulty urinating, lethargic.
